Local communities are our movement’s grassroots and the keys to its future. Donors to our Project Phoenix campaign ensure grants are available for local outreach.

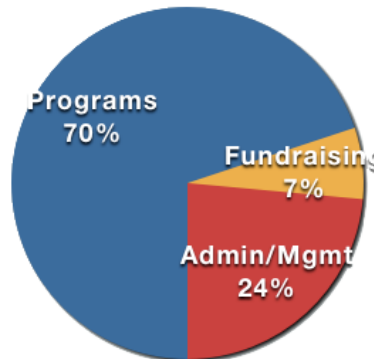
Cost of Initiative \$10,000

Our national gathering every spring shares skills, engages current issues & plans by consensus for the coming year. Conferences develop student leadership, inspire local units and activity, and renew the movement’s vision.

SCM Canada Expenses

Programs make up 70% of our budget – directly supporting students, national activities & outreach.

(Typical Budget: \$132,160)

Our annual justice exposure tour journeys to the gates of the School of the Americas army base & justice communities along the route. This program exposes students to the faith & justice movement, connected local and global issues.

Cost of Pilgrimage \$5,000
