- Current student status & familiarity with the university context at one of Montreal's major universities

- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively
- Commitment to maintaining LGBTQ+ affirming, anti-racist, and decolonizing spaces

The job requirements above describe the ideal candidate. Applicants who are passionate about this opportunity and meet many but not all of the qualifications are encouraged to apply.

Responsibilities

- Outreach, engagement, and relationship building with students on campus to grow group membership
- Plan, promote, and organize regular programs/events for SCM x St Martha's with a particular focus on faith-informed social justice
- Participate in existing St Martha's programs (Bible Study and Cathedral @ 6) at least once a month, helping occasionally with leadership when needed
- Where possible, seek student club status
- Meet regularly and as much as needed with the National Coordinator and the St Martha's Director to check in on activities and for guidance and support, and provide brief written reports on local unit activities/progress at least once a semester
- Promote SCM National programs
- Steward and use SCM & St Martha's resources and tools responsibly, including keeping general records of activities, and documenting expenses for reimbursement
